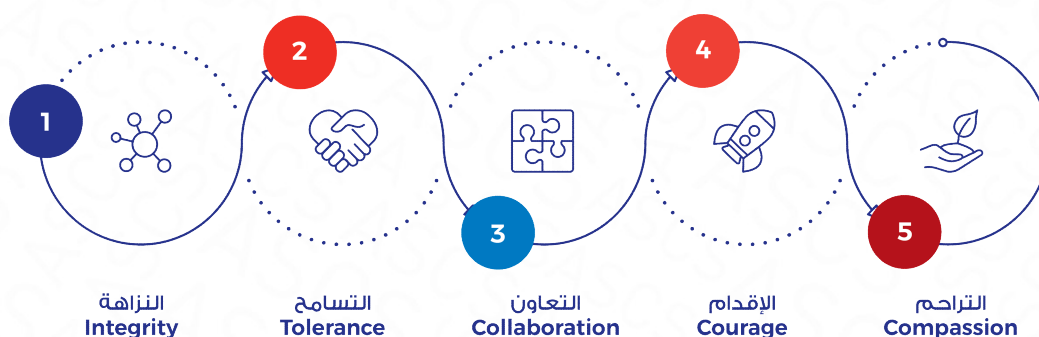

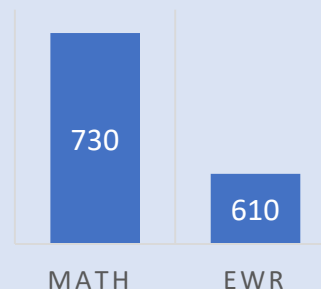
Curriculum

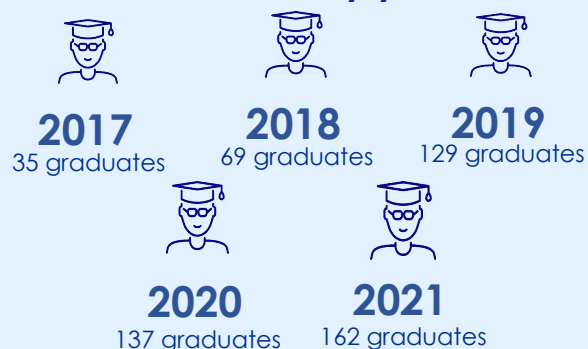
SAT TOP SCORES



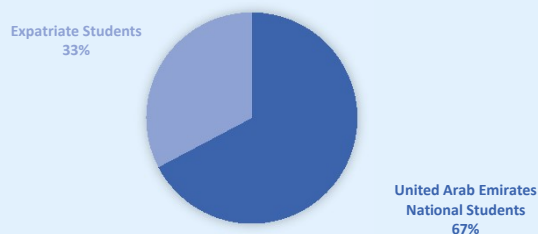

COVID-19 Response

The school moved all instruction online completely from March - July of 2020. For the 2020-2021 school year, students have the option for face-to-face instruction or distance learning for semester 1. Our school continues to abide by local policies and updates remaining flexible and prepared to transition fully online if needed. There has been no changes to the grading scale, course offerings or academic calendar. Students temporarily were unable to take the SAT, IELTS, or EmSAT exams from Feb 2020 - June 2020, however testing services have resumed.
