How to Apply

Admissions to the American School of Creative Science will be conducted on a first come first served basis in a fair manner. Admission will also be based on entrance test for each grade and stage level. Prospective students will also be required to undertake a CAT4 Cognitive Ability Test on a published date and time.

Admission procedures for new students

- Submit a copy of the student's passport, copy of each parent's Emirates ID & most recent school report or (to whom it may concern) letter from the student's current school.
- Upon receipt of the application form, the student will be invited for an entrance exam and interview. KG1 and KG2 students will be invited to school with their parents for an interview.
- Grades 1 to 8 students will be invited for a computerized examination & interview.

- The Registration Department, along with the Senior Leadership Team, will test and evaluate applications made throughout the year on a case by case basis. Admissions will be based upon availability in the grade level school/term reports and entrance/CAT4 Cognitive Ability Test results. All other registration and administrative requirements remain the same as other grade levels.

If your application is successful and the student is offered a place, you will be notified by phone or e-mail and be invited to come in to complete the rest of the admission formalities.

- A re-registration fee of AED 1,000 is a non-refundable deposit and is deductible from the first term of the tuition fees and is collected after the end of spring break.
- The total tuition fee is paid in three installments with the deposit fee at the time of registration/re-registration.
- You can pay your child's school fees online through iRusum using our selected banks' credit cards and avail easy installments for up to 12 months at a 0% profit rate.
