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School Stationary List

- To ensure safety of our students we aim to minimize sharing of certain items among students. Please find a list of items required for each child to bring to school. These items will be kept safely in an allocated box with your child's name at school and only your child will be using these during the lessons:
- If your child will have a backpack the back pack should be without wheels (to minimize spread of germs)



 Lunch box and at least 2 water bottles (for safety reasons no water dispensers are allowed to be at school



- Sanitizing wipes
- Spare clothes in a plastic bag, labeled with your child's name.
- Extra pair of shoes (KG students only) for 'inside the classroom' (easy to put on, no slippers) The shoes will be kept at school.
- **Grade 1 students** will need 2 face masks daily and their electronic device.






• Stationery:

How children learn?



Children learn by observing, exploring, listening, experimenting and by asking questions. It is therefore very important, especially in the Foundation Years, that we allow our children to engage in activities that promote this.

One of the most important components in the learning day of a young child is free, unstructured play. This is something we must remember, especially for our distance learning students. Our DL class timetable has therefore been designed to allow for students to have break from the digital screen and engage in play. Please allow your child to spend a good amount of time using Lego, playdough and to engage in pretend play (stuffed toys etc).
